

The academic year report for school year 2017/18

We write to inform you that the academic 2017/ 2018 came to a successful end from the beginning of the academic year our total enrollment was three hundred and ten students (310). Before the end of the first semester, the number dropped to two hundred and seventy students for various reasons, including relocation of parents (guardians), financial problems, sicknesses, etc.

At the end of the entire academic 2017/ 2018, the total students that completed the two semesters came to two hundred and forty (240). Of the two hundred and forty (240) two hundred and fifteen made a successful pass while twenty five ended their final courses in vacation school.

Three of our students who were thrown out of a Pentecostal Church school because they were pregnant. They became leaders of their various classes at Goll Farm. Their final exams were sent to their homes with a supervisor. Thanks to God they did not only complete their work, but also led their classes.

Finally we are happy to inform you that all of the twelve 9th grade students who sat the WAEC (West African Examination Council) Exam in May 2018 have successfully passed and will now be transferred to high schools of their choice. We rejoice in noting very few Liberian schools show 100% success on the WAEC.

Our thanks and appreciation to you for being the sources of support in our effort to improve the lives of Liberian Youth through Education.
